Our new weekly blues program, Roger White's *BluesTime International* on Wednesday mornings, is joined in September by *Crossroads* with Leslie Keros on Sunday mornings, a show focused on the intersection "where jazz meets blues" that was originally broadcast on WHPK-FM in Chicago in 2012 and aired for 73 episodes on Radio Free Amsterdam in 2014.

Face the Music by arwulf arwulf at WCBN-FM in Ann Arbor moves to Friday mornings at Radio Free Amsterdam and will be followed by Bob Putignano's venerable musical mixture called *Sounds of Blue*.

We're about to transfer another box of dusty cassettes of the *Big City Blues Cruise* with Martin Gross from WEMU-FM in the 1980s into the digital realm and add them to the 114 one-hour programs already mined from this treasure trove and broadcast on RFA, but in the meantime we're recycling four classic shows from the BCBC archive this month until we can get the new transfers ready for you.
